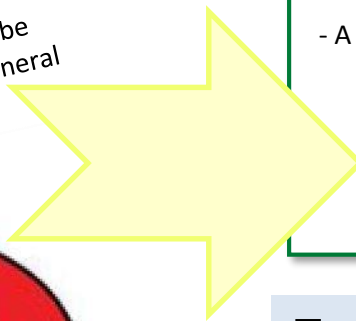
### What is Wheelienet?

Wheelienet is a fun, interactive and informative program suitable for groups of all ages from kindergarten through to adults. It is a valuable learning tool that will give participants a sound understanding of issues faced by people with disabilities, the concept of inclusion and also accident prevention.

Wheelienet can be used in a number of settings. Schools often use Wheelienet as a medium to not only promote physical activity but to also educate students and staff on the issues surrounding the topic of disability, learn ways to include other students who have disabilities in sport and play, develop new skills and discuss injury prevention issues.

### Tailoring your Program

The content of your Wheelienet session can be adapted to suit the needs of your group. A general school session will usually include:



- A talk from the presenter
- A discussion about sports and opportunities for people who have a disability
  - Accident prevention
- Question and answer time
  - Wheelchair skills
  - Wheelchair games
